The 100-MW Bethel Power Plant was proposed as a collaboration between the <u>Calista (http://www.calistacorp.com/)</u>, an Alaska Native Corporation, and the gold-mining company <u>NovaGold Resources Inc. (http://www.novagold.com/)</u> The plant was to have powered the <u>proposed Donlin Creek Gold Mine (/ Issues/MetalsMining/DonlinCreek.html)</u>, as well as Bethel and several surrounding villages. However, the <u>estimated electricity</u> costs from this plant (http://www.sourcewatch.org/index.php?

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<u>title=Bethel_Power_Plant)</u> were too high. In 2005 NovaGold scrapped the project, and is currently considering a 320-mile long natural gas pipeline for the mine.
